



OPPOSE SB274 Senator Ward and companion bill, HB91 Representative Grove.

These bills allow pharmacists to administer all vaccines to children 9 years and older, enabling them to cash in on the growing <u>multi-billion dollar industry</u> that is developing at least <u>264 more vaccines</u>.

SB274 was referred to Senate <u>Consumer Protection & Professional Licensure Committee</u>. The Committee Chair is Robert M.<u>Tomlinson</u> (717) 787-5072, (215) 638-1784. **HB91** was referred to the <u>House Health Committee</u>. The Committee Chair is Kathy <u>Rapp</u> (717) 787-1367, (814) 723-5203.

All vaccines can cause injuries or death. Manufacturer package inserts list known problems.2

The administration of vaccines, a medical procedure with potential risks, should not be done outside of a medical provider where children's health histories are known and they can be properly screened for contraindications³, including allergies and previous adverse vaccine reactions.

Pharmacists do not have adequate life-saving training or equipment that may be necessary should a severe vaccine reaction occur in their facility. For example, the package insert for the GARDASIL 9 HPV, states:

"5.1 Syncope - Because vaccinees may develop syncope⁴, sometimes resulting in falling with injury, observation for 15 minutes after administration is recommended. Syncope, sometimes associated with tonic-clonic movements and other seizure-like activity, has been reported following HPV vaccination."

"5.2 Managing Allergic Reactions - Appropriate medical treatment and supervision must be readily available in case of anaphylactic reactions following the administration of GARDASIL 9."

This statement alone should be enough to kill these bills.
